All voters will be asked to show one form of identification. Any voter who does not have identification may sign a written statement to vote.

HAVA requirements: [42 USC § 15483\(b\)\(2\)](#); Va. Code § [24.2-643\(E\)](#)

- (i) a current and valid photo identification; or
- (ii) a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document that shows the name and address of the voter.

Virginia requirements: Va. Code § [24.2-643\(B\)](#)

- his Commonwealth of Virginia voter registration card,
- his social security card,
- his valid Virginia driver's license,
- or any other identification card issued by a government agency of the Commonwealth, one of its political subdivisions, or the United States,
- or any valid employee identification card containing a photograph of the voter and issued by an employer of the voter in the ordinary course of the employer's business.

Identification is considered current and timely if it has expired within 30 days of the election.

ⁱ Political subdivisions include recognized Indian tribes and governmental divisions with authority to make rules and regulations having force of law. *See* Va. Code §§ 8.01-385, 51.1-700. Eight tribes include: Chickahominy, Eastern Chickahominy, Mattaponi, Monacan, Nansemond, Pamunkey, Rappahannock, & Upper Mattaponi.

ⁱⁱ Any voter that shows identification with an address that does not match their address on the pollbook will be asked questions to determine their eligibility to vote and may need to complete some paperwork before voting.
