I feel that the definition of residency should be the location where a person lives and pays local and/or real estate and/or personal property taxes. Official residencies of dependent students should be the location where they resided with their parent(s) or guardian(s) when they were admitted to that school or where their parent(s) or guardian(s) move during the time they are enrolled in that particular school. The provision for permitting students to vote in a jurisdiction by merely stating that they intend to live in that location should not be included in the definition of residency.
