Dear James,

I have just read Tracy Howard's email which reminded me of a couple of other comments.

I, too, was concerned about the additional information having to be in writing, especially if the individual is in the office completing his VRA. Could there be a pre-printed form which we might use? Or could the applicant simply amend his VRA right then and there. In which case, you might want to change 16 f to say "...must be in writing unless the additional information is provided in person to the registrar."

The question, "Do you have a specific plan to move from this county/city at a fixed date in the future?," will be very confusing to the applicants. It is similar to the question asked of UOCAVA applicants ("what was your last date of residence ...") which, when answered incorrectly because they do not understand what is really being asked, affects the category into which they are assigned.
